Our topic this half-term

Geography: Where in Europe?

This half term we are looking at the physical and human geographical features. We are also aiming to be able to identify different countries in Europe and different cities and counties in the UK. We will also be comparing the geographical gestures of different localities.



English: In English we are focussing on writing fiction. Our project is a series of 100 words to encourage precise and ambitious vocabulary. We will be writing descriptions of settings, building suspense, and character description.

<u>Maths:</u> We are continuing to practice our 1 - 12x tables. We are focusing on fractions. We will be adding and subtracting fractions, multiplying and dividing fractions by whole numbers, finding fractions of amounts.

<u>Computing</u>: In computing we will be learning how to handle input into 2 code; learning how to create programs that count up and down creating different number sequences as well as creating programs that complete calculations.

<u>History:</u> We are focusing on William I, exploring his personality, his role in the battle of Hastings and investigating whether he was fit enough to be King.

<u>PSHE:</u> We will be encouraging children to investigate ways that they can remain focus and calm at home and providing them with different strategies through things like Yoga and mediation. The aim is to be able to self regulate your emotions.
